

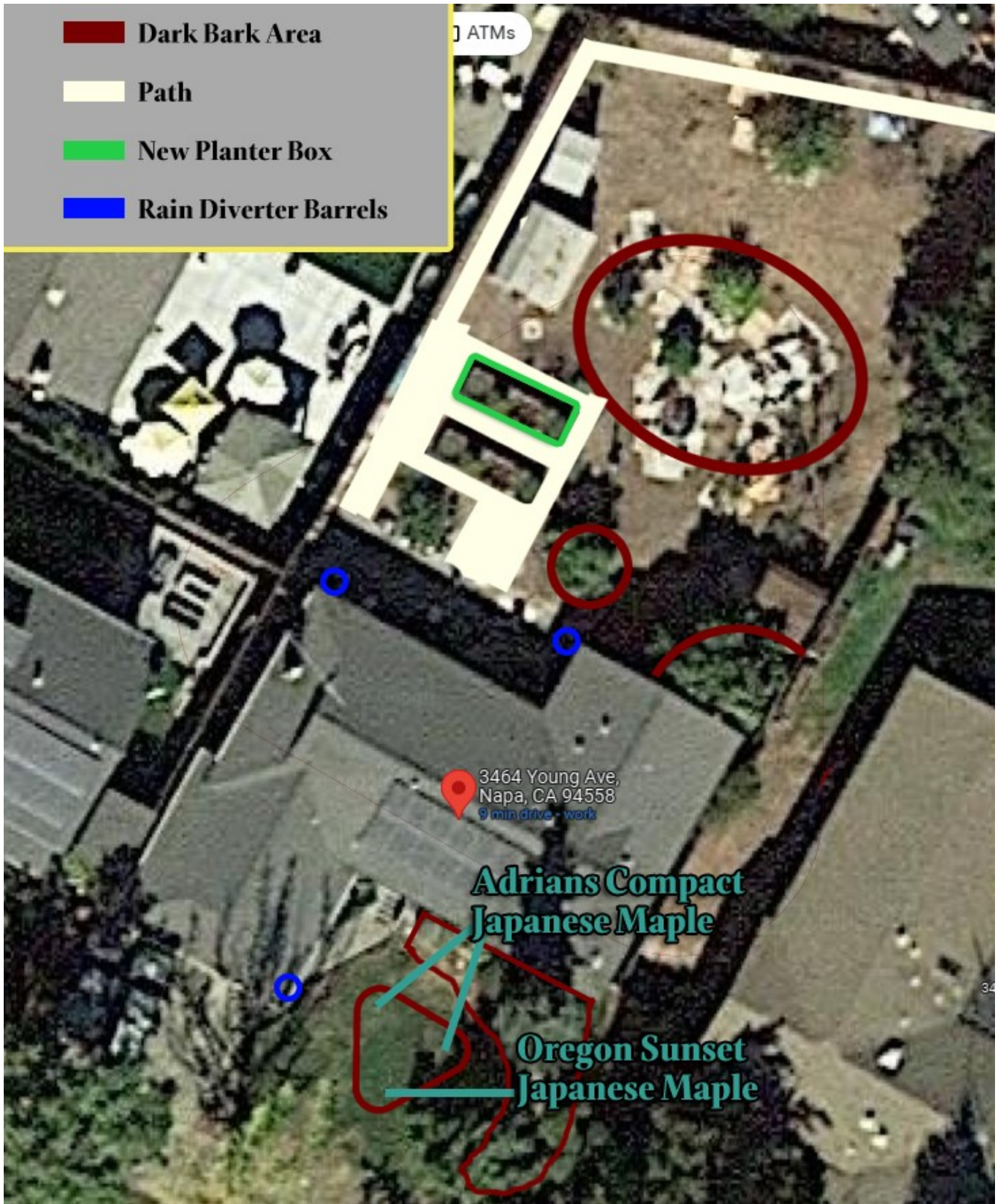

Front Yard

There are 9 items that we would like to change in the front yard.

1. We would like to remove the lawn and replace it with a mostly with rocks. We would like black plastic to be put down before we add the rocks, bark, and trees to reduce getting weeds in the future. We'd like to get rocks in this color, but if possible we'd like to rocks to be smooth/tumbled.



2. We also want to add a dark colored bark and 3 Japanese maple trees. The shade of the bark should be similar to the color in the image to the right. We want to add the Japanese maple trees in a triangle formation in the center of the front yard, with an Oregon Sunset Japanese maple tree in the front and 2 Adrians Compact Japanese maple trees in the back. We want the whole area inside of the triangle made by the Japanese maples to be filled with bark.



3. Aside from that triangle there is one other area we want bark. Near the house there are a set of shrubberies and a large pine tree. It's kind of hard to see in pictures, but there is a bit of a natural divide between the lawn and those plants. That divide sort of curves towards the persimmon tree. We'd like to have bark that in that natural divide area and have it curve and go around the trunk of the persimmon tree.



4. We want to install 3 Good Ideas Savannah 45 Gal. Light Granite Rain Barrels. 1 for the front yard and 2 in the back yard. It's getting harder to find so you can get them from the good ideas site.

If you cannot find the light granite one, we are okay with the sandstone one. If sandstone is also unavailable the go with dark granite.



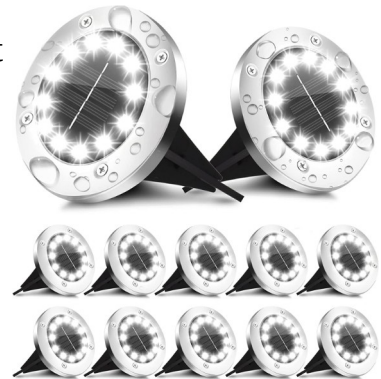


5. The railing at the front porch is falling apart. We would like to have it replaced. Currently our preference is to replace it with a vinyl rail, but we are okay with would if you think that is best. If you are replacing it with another wood railing, we have paint for both the color of the house and the trim color so there is no need to purchase that.

6. In the garden area next to the garage there is ivy growing. We want that removed.

7. Add a wall mounted hose hanger near the faucet.

8. In the lawn area right next to the driveway and also next to the walkway to the front of the house. We want to have Solar ground lights with a cool white color, preferably ultra bright and spaced every 4 feet. We will also want these along the back yard path as well.



9. In front of each of the 3 Japanese maple trees we want solar spot lights. Again cool white in color and ultra bright if possible. We would like them in front of each of the new fruit trees in the back yard as well.



Back and Side Yards

There are 16 items that we would like to change in the back yard.

1. The back yard is mostly filled with weeds, we want to fill most of that space with mostly rocks. We would like black plastic to be put down before we add the rocks, bark, and trees to reduce getting weeds in the future. Just like the front yard we'd like to get rocks in this color, but if possible we'd like to rocks to be smooth/tumbled. Before laying down the plastic we'd like to add a layer of topsoil around the trees.



2. We also want to add a dark colored bark around the fruit trees. The shade of the bark should be similar to the color in the image to the right. We want a circle around the small orange tree, a semi circle around the large orange tree and a long oval that encases all of the new fruit trees.



3. We want to create a path made of... I'm not sure how to describe it so see the image to the right. Those bricks are roughly 22-24 inches in length on one side. We want this path to follow along the northern and eastern fence line, surround the raised planter boxes (more on that later) and extend the area in front of the 1st planter box up to the concrete. Also next to this path we want to have solar ground lights with a cool white color, preferably ultra bright and spaced every 4 feet.



4. We want this orange tree which is currently located in the patio area planted in the same area as the newer fruit trees.



5. The avocado tree was planted in the wrong place. We need it replanted into the spot shown in the picture to the right. I should warn you, there is a very small dead tree already in that spot that will need to be removed.



6. Our current/older lemon tree does not produce fruit. We were given a new lemon tree. Unfortunately before I could remove the old lemon tree or stop the new tree from being planted someone else planted it in an inconvenient spot. We need to remove the old lemon tree(shown on the left) and if possible move the new one (shown on the right)into the spot of the old lemon tree.



7. Speaking of removing things, we would like to have multiple plants and items removed. The 2 dead trees, the rusted shed next to the large orange tree, the apple tree next to the large dead tree and shed, the lattice work behind the planter box and the shrubbery on the corner of the house next to the sliding doors.



8. There are 3 shrubberies near the planter box. We would like the ones on the left and right removed while keeping the center one.



9. We would like to move the bricks in the back yard over to the side of the house. We want to replace the area where the bricks were with concrete that matches the design of the rest of the concrete. With the bricks we want to have them go all the way to the breaker box, but we only want to the bricks to extend at most halfway between the side of the house and the fence. We want to leave dirt on the other half.



10. On the big orange tree, we would like to top trimmed by 3.5-4 feet, the side closest to the shed by 3.5 feet and the side closest to the house by 1.5 feet.

11. Add a wall mounted hose hanger near the faucet.



12. We want to add another planter box. We want it in the same or similar size and style as the one we already have. It's hard to see in pictures, but behind the latticework there is a hump of dirt, that is where we would like the new planter box. There is also one plant that we would like to have replanted into the planter box. There is an image of that plant below on the right.



13. We would like an ultra dwarf beverly hills apple tree planted in the same area as the newer fruit trees. If you can't find an ultra dwarf tree then a regular dwarf tree will do.

14. If possible we want a drip line timer water system for the newer trees.

15. In front of each of the newer fruit trees we want to have a solar spotlight. We want to have the lights be a cool white color and be ultra bright if possible.



16. Lastly is the green bean trellis. Just leave it as it is.
